# Where is Brenda?

## Four years after sister's disappearance, Clearfield woman still has many questions

**BELLEFONTE** - Four years is a long time not to see or hear from someone you love. It's a long time to live with questions about that loved one's fate.

The two children of Brenda Louise Condon Condon, now aged 14 and 16, as well as her sister and best friend, have had to live with these questions and the pain that is inherent to them.

Ms. Condon was working as a bartender at Carl's Bad Tavern in Spring Township on the night of Feb. 26, 1991, when she disappeared. The tavern was found unlocked the next morning with her car, locked, in the parking lot where she had parked it when coming to work.

"I never really thought she was alive from the first," said Ms. Condon's sister Iris Myers of Clearfield, in an interview
